Bliain na Gaeilge

Sheol an Taoiseach Bliain na Gaeilge i mí na Nollag 2017. Cuireann An Bord Pleanála fáilte roimh Ghaeilge agus tacaímid Bliain na Gaeilge 2018.

Táimid tiomanta dár ndualgais agus ngealltanais a chomhlíonadh maidir le comhionannas teanga oifigiúla. Mar shampla:

- Freagraímid ár gcomhfhreagras scríofa as Gaeilge má fhaighimid comhfhreagras as Gaeilge.

- Cuirimid fáilte roimh an bpobal san fháiltiú má theastaíonn ó dhaoine Gaeilge a úsáid.
- Bainfidh na héisteachtaí ó bhéal úsáid as an nGaeilge má bhíonn

Bliain na Gaeilge

The Taoiseach launched Year of the Irish Language in December 2017. An Bord Pleanála welcomes the use of the Irish language and supports Bliain na Gaeilge 2018.

We are committed to fulfilling our obligations and commitments in relation to official languages equality. Examples include:

- We respond to written communications in Irish where we receive communications in Irish.
- We respond to telephone call queries in Irish at the time of the call or a returned call from a nominated staff member.
- We welcome members of the public in our reception who wish to use Irish.
- Oral hearings will use Irish if taking place in a Gaeltacht area or if

Cuireadh an [tríú Scéim Teanga](#) faoi Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla i bhfeidhm in 2015. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an scéim seo dul chun cinn a dhéanamh ar scéimeanna a bhí ann cheana trí chaomhnú agus feabhsú seirbhísí tríd an dá teanga oifigiúil (Gaeilge agus Béarla).

Le linn Bliain na Gaeilge, cuirfidh Coiste na Gaeilge an Bhoird Pleanála imeachtaí ar siúl chun an fhoireann a mhealladh a gcúpla focal a úsáid le linn an lae oibre. Chomh maith leis na himeachtaí seo, tá tacaíochtaí eile ar fáil don fhoireann i gcomhthéacs na teanga, le ranganna Gaeilge agus tacaíocht do bhaill foirne a bhfuil suim acu freastal ar chúrsaí traenála sa Ghaeltacht mar shampla.

- Static information such as guides, webpages and general information are published in both Irish and English at the same time.

Our [third Language Scheme](#) under the Official Languages Act was adopted in 2015. This scheme seeks to build on previous schemes by maintaining and enhancing services through both official languages (Irish and English).

During Bliain na Gaeilge, our internal Irish Committee will host events to encourage staff to use a cúpla focal during the work day. This is in addition to An Bord Pleanála's other supports for the language to staff including Irish language classes and supports for staff who wish to attend training courses in the Gaeltacht.
